WHAT IS American Theater Workshop (ATW)?

 It consists of 2 hour sessions that lasts 19 weeks in which participants will develop skills in writing, creating and staging a show.

WHY ATW?

- Explore your creativity and collaborate with other young aspiring theater creators.
- Every participant will create a 5 10 minute play on whatever subject speaks to them. They will also get to act in them.
- At the end of the workshop a collection of the short plays written by the participants will be showcased.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

- Youth (11 15; 16 18 years old), interested in the arts, performance, play-writing, and that can work collaboratively with other young artists.
- Those who can commit 100% to all the dates and times of the program
- Those with a sense of artistic adventure, willingness to learn, experiment and grow.
